ABSTRACT

The report includes among other details; the prison population growth, convict-remand ratio, occupancy levels, prison escapes and deaths, and the staff strength during the month of May, 2026.

To note therefore is that between the month of April and May 2026;

- The daily average prison population increased by 1.5% from 80,010 to 81,224 prisoners;
- Convicts increased by 1.8% from 42,833 to 43,619 prisoners;
- Remands increased by 1.1% from 36,493 to 36,883 prisoners;
- Civil debtors increased by 5.6% from 684 to 722 debtors;
- Proportion of remand prisoners decreased by 0.2% from 45.6% to 45.4%;
- Occupancy rate increased by 4.0% from 344.1% to 348.1%;
- Prisons holding capacity increased by 0.3% from 23,254 to 23,334 prisoners.

To note also is that, during the month of May, 2026;

- A total of 2,610 convicted prisoners were normally released after completion of their sentences – *a daily average of 104 releases*;
- Number of prisoners produced to courts were 33,943 – *a daily average of 1,697 prisoners*;
- 9,700 prisoners were newly admitted from court while 6,376 were released from courts due to various reasons;
- For the period July 2025 and May 2026, prison escape rate was 2.6 escapees per 1,000 prisoners, recapture rate at 53.4%, while mortality rate stood at 2.1 per 1,000 prisoners;
- Overall, staff strength was 14,814 with male staff accounting for 10,298 (69.5%) and female staff accounting for 4,516 (30.5%);
- 11,757 (82.0%) of the uniformed staff were deployed in the 270 custodial prison units countrywide;
- Staff attrition for the period between July 2025 and May 2026 was 275 staff including 18 staff for the month of May 2026.
- The staff-to-prisoner ratio remained at 1:7.

1.1 Population Change

During the month of May 2026, the overall daily average prison population increased by 1.5% (1,214) from 80,010 in April 2026 to 81,224 prisoners.

During the same period as observed from Table 1.1:

- a) Convicts increased by 1.8% from 42,833 to 43,619;
- b) Remands increased by 1.1% from 36,493 to 36,883;
- c) Civil/judgment debtors increased by 5.6% from 684 to 722;
- d) Prisons holding capacity increased by 0.3% from 23,254 to 23,334 prisoners. This resulted from completion of 02 prison wards at UG. Prison Isingiro each of capacity 40 prisoners.
- e) Occupancy rate increased by 4.0% from 344.1% to 348.1%.

1.2 Percentage composition of Remands, Convicts and Debtors

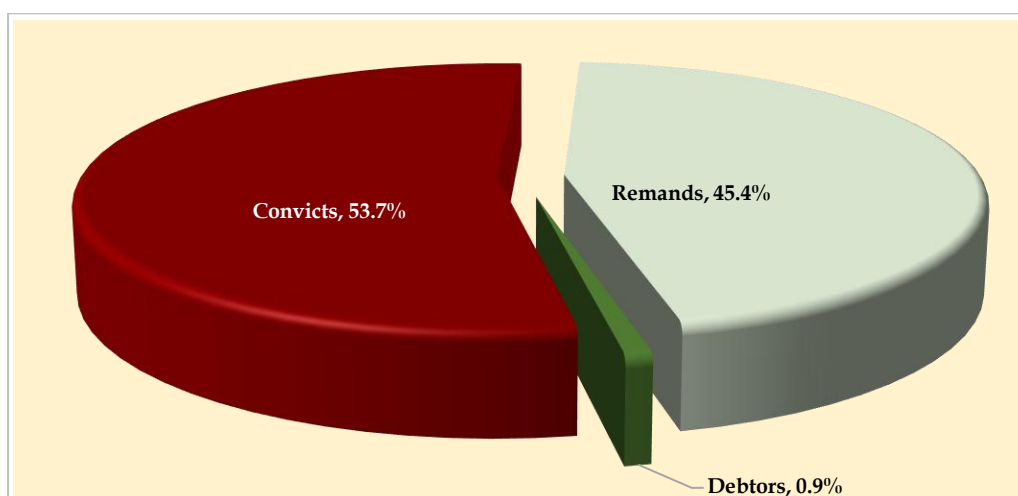


Figure 1.1 Composition of the Prison population

During the month of May 2026, convicted prisoners composed of 53.7%, remand prisoners composed of 45.4%, while civil debtors composed of 0.9%, of the daily average prison population as indicated in Figure 1.1 above.

1.3 Percentage composition change of Remands, Convicts, and Debtors

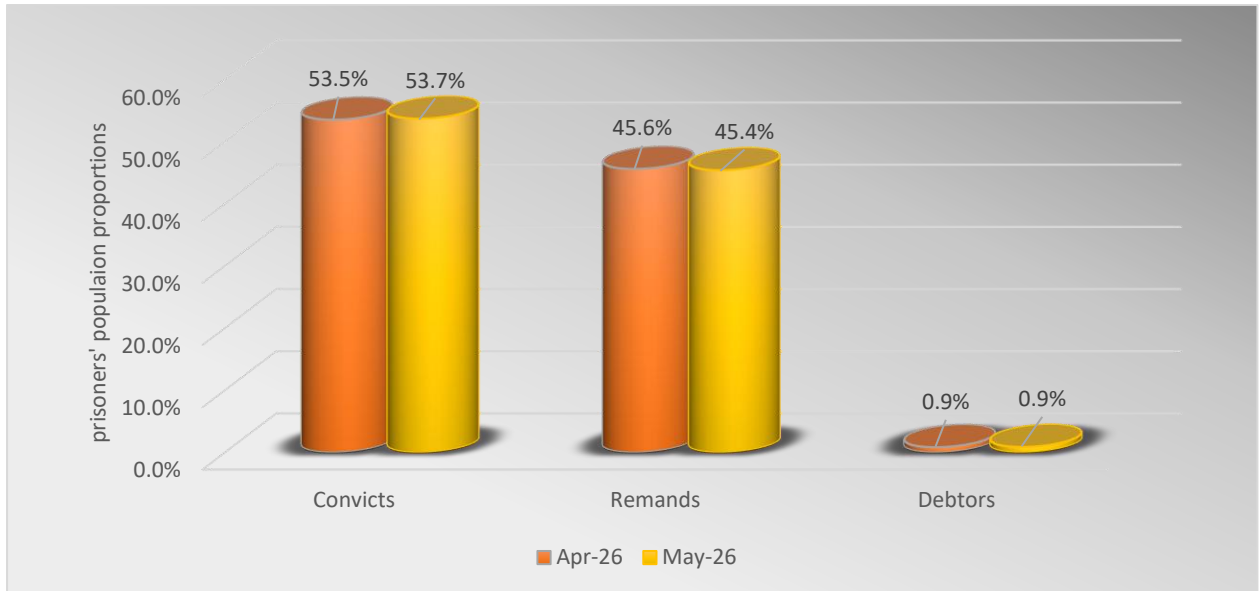


Figure 1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors

In comparison with the month of April 2026, the percentage composition of convicted prisoners increased by 0.2% from 53.5% to 53.7%, remand prisoners decreased by 0.2% from 45.6% to 45.4% while that of civil debtors remained at 0.9%; of the average prison population in May 2026 as indicated in the Figure 1.2 above.

1.4 Monthly Prison Population trends from July 2025 to May 2026

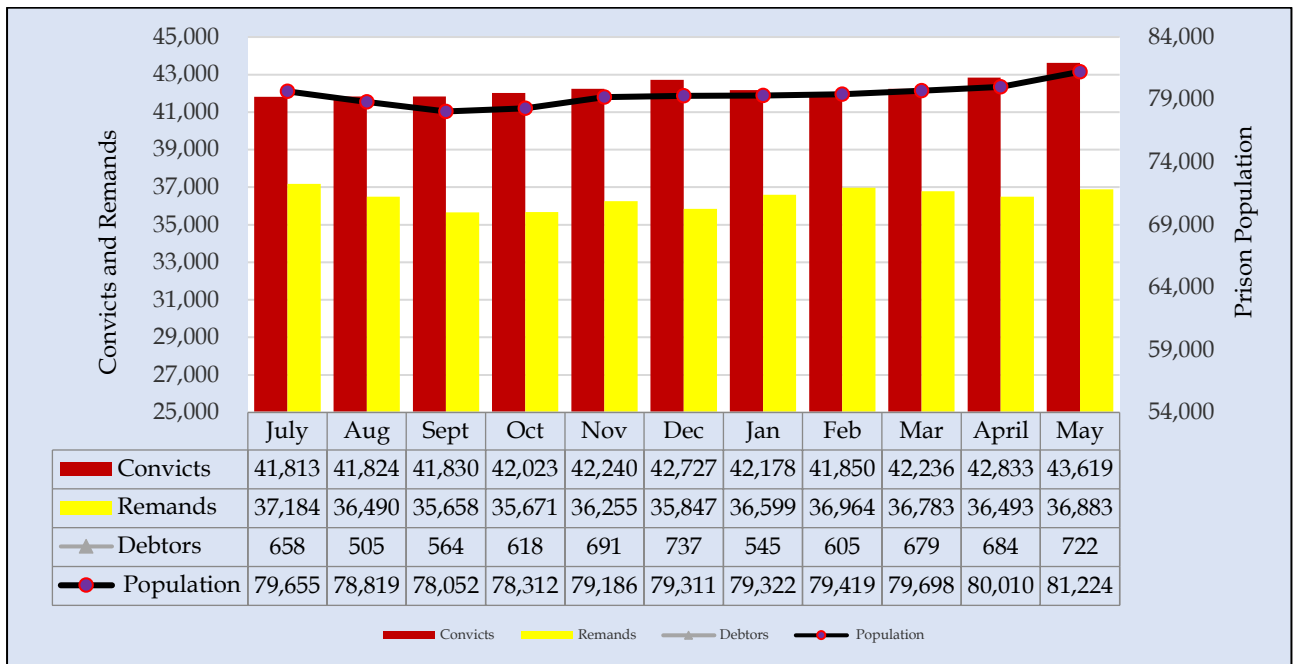


Figure 1.3 Monthly prison population trend for the period July 2025-May 2026

Figure 1.3 above illustrates the trend in prison population from July 2025 through May 2026. The above chart shows an overall decline in the prison population during the first three months of the financial year 2025/26. Throughout this time, the number of prisoners gradually dropped from 79,655 in July 2025 to 78,052 in September 2025. The prison population count, however, steadily rose from 78,312 prisoners recorded in October 2025 to the current 81,224 prisoners in May 2026.

1.5 Prison population composition trends from July 2025 to May 2026

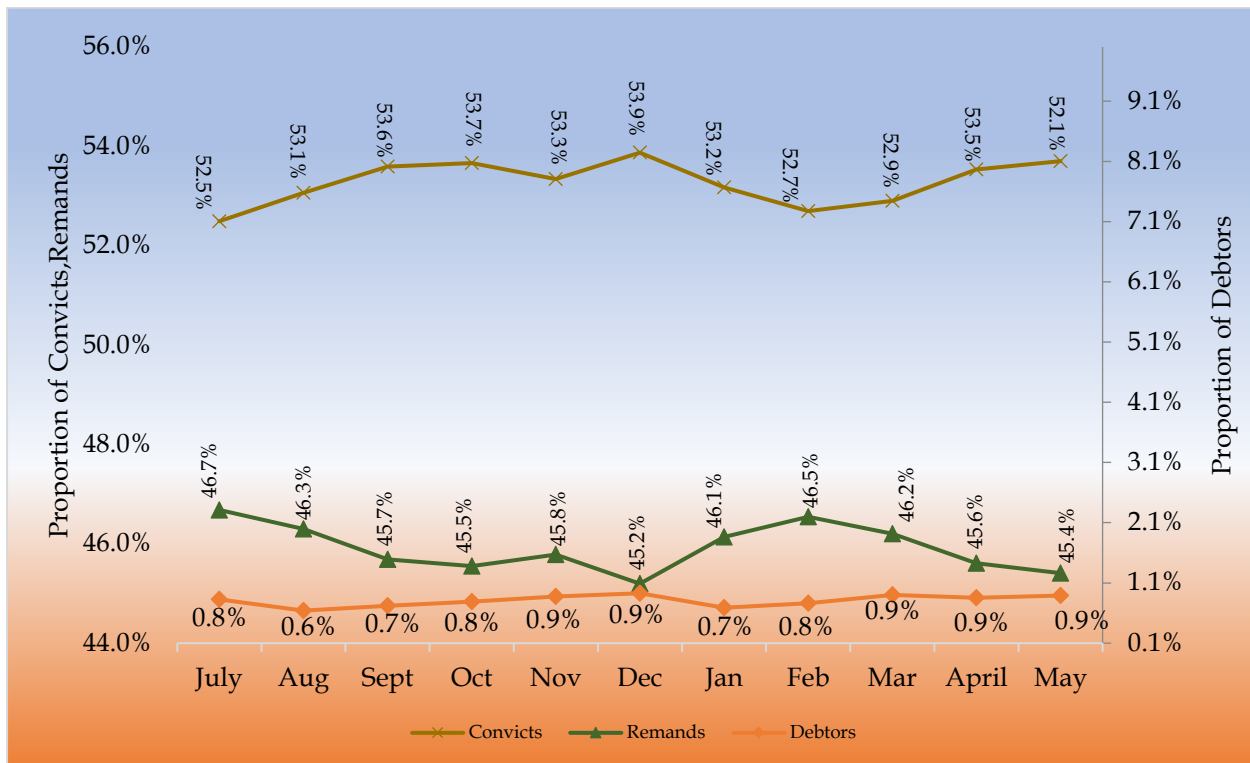


Figure 1.4 Composition trends of convicts, remands, and debtors for the period between July 2025 and May 2026

Figure 1.4 above illustrates the ratio of convicts, remands, and debtors of the overall prison population from July 2025 to May 2026. The percentage of the remand population fluctuated below the 50.0% threshold, dropping from 46.7% in July 2025 to 45.2% in December 2025, then rising to 45.4% in May 2026. Conversely, the percentage of convicts fluctuated above the 50.0% threshold, rising from 52.5% in July 2025 to 53.9% in December 2025, followed by a slight drop to 52.1% in May 2026. The average percentage of debtors was 0.8% of the total prison population throughout the entire duration.

Table 1.2 shows that during the month of May, 2026;

1. The regional prison population increased in the following regions; Kooki by 8.7%; Mid Central by 3.7%; Mid Northern by 3.2%; Southern and Western by 3.0%; Kigezi by 2.8%; South Western by 2.7%; Mid Western by 2.0%; Kampala Extra and Eastern by 1.9%; North Western by 1.4%; East Central by 1.3%; North Central by 1.1%; and Iganga by 0.1%.
2. The regional prison population however, decreased in the following regions; North Eastern by 1.8%, Northern by 1.5%; Mid Eastern by 1.4%; South Eastern by 0.2%; and Central by 0.1%.

3. The average number of children staying in prisons with their incarcerated mothers was 261.
4. The average number of debtors in custody was 722.
5. The staff to prisoner ratio remained at 1:7. The number of prisoners per custodial staff ranged between four (4) and eleven (11) across the 19 administrative regions.

1.7 Status of Congestion/Occupancy levels in prison units

Table 1.3 below shows the levels of congestion in prisons during the month of May 2026. Only 7.4% of the prisons (20 prison units) were extremely congested with occupancy levels of above 600%. 142 prison units were very congested with congestion levels of above 300% upto 600%, representing 52.6% of the total prison units and 38 prison units had congestion levels below 200%. During the month of May 2026, the outturn of prisoners delivered to judicial courts countrywide to access justice decreased by 24.1% from 44,719 in April 2026 to 33,943 prisoners, a daily average of 1,697 prisoners. (See Table 1.4).

The outturn of normal releases of convicts in May 2026 increased by 1.6% from 2,570 in April 2026 to 2,610 prisoners, a daily average of 104 normal releases of convicts (See Table 1.4).

1.9 Releases of remand prisoners

The outturn of prisoners released from court during the month of May 2026 decreased by 32.8% from 9,487 in April 2026 to 6,376 prisoners. The breakdown is as shown in Table 1.5 below.

In comparison with the month of April 2026, the number of prisoners who escaped from lawful custody during the month of May 2026 increased by 12.5% from 16 prison escapes to 18 prison escapes. Despite an increase in the number of escapes, the monthly escape rate remained at 0.2 escapes per 1,000 prisoners due to the 1.5% increase in prison population as indicated in Table 1.9 above.

Table 1.10 shows the recorded prison escapes that occurred from July 2025 to May 2026. Kooki region registered the highest escape rate of 12.2 escapees per 1,000 prisoners, while Kampala Extra Region recorded the lowest rate at 0.1 per 1,000 prisoners. The overall prison escape rate for the time period was 2.6 escapees for every 1,000 prisoners. It is important to highlight that, out of the 204 prisoners who had escaped from lawful custody during this period, 109 had been recaptured, indicating a recapture rate of 53.4%.

1.12 Prison Mortality

During the month of May 2026, the Service lost a total of seventeen (17) prisoners through deaths, majority of whom died from Murchison Bay prison where the prison National Referral Hospital is located.

The number of prison deaths recorded during the month of May 2026 was 17, a decrease by 22.7% from 22 deaths registered during the previous month (April 2026) as indicated in Table 1.12 above. The monthly crude mortality rate decreased from 0.3 deaths per 1,000 prisoners to 0.2 deaths per 1,000 prisoners.

Table 1.13 above shows the prison mortality recorded between July 2025 and May 2026. Kampala Extra region had the highest crude mortality rate at 7.0 deaths per 1,000 prisoners while North Eastern Region recorded no prison death during the time period. The overall prison deaths in the time period was 164 against the daily average prison population of 79,365 prisoners, reflecting an overall crude mortality rate of 2.1 deaths per 1,000 prisoners.

2 STAFFING POSITION

2.1 Staff Strength

The Service staff strength as at 31st May 2026 was 14,814 constituting 10,298 (69.5%) males and 4,516 (30.5%) females. Of the same strength, 14,335 were uniformed staff while 479 were non-uniformed staff.

Of the 14,335 uniformed staff, 11,757 (82.0%) were deployed in custodial units across the 270 Prisons countrywide. Therefore, the overall staff-to-prisoner ratio was 1:7 against the ideal of 1:3.
