ABSTRACT

The report includes among other details; the prison population growth, convict-remand ratio, occupancy levels, escapes, deaths and the staff strength during the month of June , 2025. To note therefore is that;

- The daily average population of prisoners decreased by 0.2% from 79,933 in May, 2025 to 79,804 prisoners;
- Convicts decreased by 0.7% from 41,439 to 41,161;
- Remands increased by 0.5% from 37,855 to 38,062;
- Civil debtors decreased by 9.1% from 639 to 581;
- Occupancy rate decreased by 4.0% from 360.0% to 356.0%;
- Remands composed of 47.7%, convicts 51.6%, and debtors 0.7% of the daily average prisoners' population respectively;
- A total of 2,201 convicted prisoners were normally released after completion of their sentences – *a daily average of 96 releases*;
- Number of prisoners produced to courts were 36,335 – *a daily average of 1,912 prisoners*;
- 8,973 prisoners were newly admitted from court while 6,895 were released from courts due to various reasons;
- For the FY2024/25, prisoners' escape rate was 4.1 escapees per 1,000 prisoners, recapture rate at 48.5%, while mortality rate stood at 2.5 per 1,000 prisoners;
- The Service staff strength was 13,871 with 13,383 (96.5%) uniformed and 488 (3.5%) non-uniformed staff;
- Overall, Male staff accounted for 69.5%; Female staff accounted for 30.5%;
- 11,276 (84.5%) of the uniformed staff were deployed in the 269 custodial prison units countrywide;
- The staff-to-prisoner ratio remained at 1:7.
- Prisons holding capacity increased from 22,203 to 22,419 prisoners resulting from construction and renovation of prisoners wards at Loro, Yumbe, Bisso, Amolatar, Ngogwe, and Nakasongola (M).

1.1 Population Change

During the month of June, 2025, the overall daily average population of prisoners decreased by 0.2% (129) from 79,933 in May, 2025 to 79,804.

During the same period as observed from Table 1.1:

- Convicts decreased by 0.7% from 41,439 to 41,161;
- Remands increased by 0.5% from 37,855 to 38,062;
- Civil/judgment debtors decreased by 9.1% from 639 to 581;
- Holding capacity increased by 1.0% from 22,203 to 22,419;
- Occupancy rate decreased by 4.0% from 360.0% at 356.0%.

1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors




Figure 1.1 Composition of Prisoners' population

During the month of June, 2025, convicted prisoners composed of 51.6%, remand prisoners composed of 47.7%, while civil debtors composed of 0.7%, of the daily average prisoners' population as indicated in Figure 1.1 above.

1.3 Percentage composition change of Remands, Convicts, and Debtors




Figure 1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors

In comparison with May, 2025, the percentage composition of convicted prisoners decreased by 0.2% from 51.8% to 51.6%, remand prisoners increased by 0.3% from 47.4% to 47.7% while that of civil debtors reduced by 0.1% from 0.8% to 0.7%; of the average prisoners' population in June, 2025 as indicated in the Figure 1.2 above.

1.4 Monthly Prison population trends for the FY2024/25




Figure 1.3 Monthly prison population trend for the FY2024/25

Figure 1.3 shows the prisoners' population trend for the FY2024/25 from July, 2024 to June, 2025. The figure indicates a downward trend for the first four months during which the monthly prisoners population decreased from 79,530 prisoners in July, 2024 to 78,057 prisoners in October, 2024. The prisoners population thereafter started increasing to the current 79,804 prisoners in the month of June, 2025. The general rise in prisoners' population may be attributed to increased crime rate, vigilancy of law enforcement agencies in apprehending criminals before, during and after the festive season.

1.5 Prison population trends for the FY2024/25




Figure 1.4 Composition trends of convicts, remands, and debtors for the FY2024/25

Figure 1.4 shows the proportion of convicts, remands, and debtors of the total prisoners' population in the FY2024/25. The proportion of the remand population oscillated below the 50.0% mark, ranging between 46.7% and 47.8% for the entire time period. On the other hand, the proportion of convicts oscillated above the 50.0% mark, ranging between 51.5% and 52.6% for the entire time period.

On average, the proportion of debtors was 0.8% of the overall prisoners' population for the entire period.

During the month of June, 2025;

1. The regional population of prisoners increased in the following regions; Kooki by 4.9%; North Central by 4.1%; East Central by 3.8%; Mid Northern by 1.1%; Southern by 1.0%; Northern by 0.03%; and North Western by 0.02%.
2. The regional population of prisoners however, decreased in the following regions; Mid Central by 6.1%, Central by 2.2%; Iganga by 1.9%; North Eastern by 1.7%, Kigezi by 1.6%; South Easern by 1.5%; Eastern by 0.5%; Kampala Extra by 0.3%; Western by 0.2%; Mid Western and South Western by 0.1%. The regional prisoners' population change was largely attributed to transfer of inmates

between regions to attend courts and reinforce farm labour, and as a decongestion measure.

3. The average number of children staying in prisons with their incarcerated mothers was 303.
4. The average number of debtors in custody was 581.
5. The staff to prisoner ratio remained at 1:7. The number of prisoners per custodial staff ranged between four (4) and ten (10) across the 269 custodial units countrywide.

1.7 Status of Congestion/Occupancy levels in prison

Table 1.3 shows the levels of congestion in prison during the month of June, 2025. 9.7% (26 prison units) were extremely congested with occupancy levels of above 600%. 149 prisons units were very congested composing 55.4% of the total prisons units. Only 24 prison units composing 8.9% had congestion levels below 200%. See Appendix 1 showing the stations under each category.

During the month of June, 2025, the outturn of prisoners delivered to judicial courts countrywide to access justice increased by 3.6% from 35,062 in May, 2025 to 36,335 prisoners, a daily average of 1,912 prisoners. (*See Table 1.4*).

The outturn of normal releases of convicts in June, 2025 decreased by 4.9% from 2,315 in May, 2025 to 2,201 prisoners, a daily average of 96 normal releases of convicts (*See Table 1.4*).

1.9 Releases of remand prisoners

The outturn of prisoners released from court during the month of June, 2025 increased by 14.2% from 6,039 in May, 2025 to 6,895 prisoners. The breakdown is as shown in Table 1.5 below.

Table 1.10 indicates the escapes registered during the FY2024/25. Eastern region registered the highest number of escapes (29 escapees), however the number of escapees per 1,000 prisoners was highest in Kooki region at 13.8 escapees per 1,000 prisoners. Kampala Extra region was the only region with zero escapes during the time period. The overall escape rate during the period was 4.1 escapees per 1,000 prisoners. It is noteworthy that out of the 324 prisoners who had escaped from lawful custody during the period, 157 had been recaptured, representing a recapture rate of 48.5%.

1.12 Mortality of Prisoners

During the month of June, 2025, the service lost a total of nine (09) prisoners through death which reflects a monthly mortality rate of 0.1 deaths per 1,000 prisoners.

Table 1.13 shows the mortality of prisoners registered during the FY2024/25. Kampala Extra region had the highest crude mortality rate at 8.0 deaths per 1,000 prisoners. Kooki region had zero deaths of prisoners during the time period. The overall number of deaths in the time period was 199 against the daily average population of 79,153 prisoners, reflecting an overall crude mortality rate of 2.5 deaths per 1,000 prisoners.

2 STAFFING POSITION

2.1 Staff Strength

The Service staff strength as at 30th June, 2025 was 13,871 of which 13,383 (96.5%) were uniformed and 488 (3.5%) non-uniformed officers. The staff strength composed of 9,643 (69.5%) males and 4,228 (30.5%) females – see Table 2.1 below.

Out of the 13,383 uniformed staff, 11,276 (84.3%) were deployed in custodial units across the 269 Prisons countrywide. Therefore, the overall staff-to-prisoner ratio was 1:7 against the ideal of 1:3.
