ABSTRACT

The report includes among other details; the prison population growth, convict-remand ratio, occupancy levels, prison escapes and deaths, and the staff strength during the month of March, 2026.

To note therefore is that between the month of February and March 2026;

- The daily average prison population increased by 0.4% from 79,419 to 79,698 prisoners;
- Convicts increased by 0.9% from 41,850 to 42,236;
- Remands decreased by 0.5% from 36,964 to 36,783;
- Civil debtors increased by 12.2% from 605 to 679;
- Proportion of remand prisoners decreased by 0.3% from 46.5% to 46.2%;
- Occupancy rate increased by 0.1% from 342.6% to 342.7%;
- Prisons holding capacity increased by 0.3% from 23,184 prisoners to 23,254 prisoners

To note also is that, during the month of March, 2026;

- A total of 2,738 convicted prisoners were normally released after completion of their sentences – *a daily average of 105 releases*;
- Number of prisoners produced to courts were 42,835 – *a daily average of 1,947 prisoners*;
- 11,957 prisoners were newly admitted from court while 9,111 were released from courts due to various reasons;
- For the period July 2025 and March 2026, prisoners' escape rate was 2.1 escapees per 1,000 prisoners, recapture rate at 52.4%, while mortality rate stood at 1.6 per 1,000 prisoners;
- 1,238 Trainees (912 males and 326 females) were still undergoing training at the Prisons Academy and Training School, Luzira.
- Overall, staff strength was 14,850 with male staff accounting for 10,337 (69.6%) and female staff accounting for 4,513 (30.4%);
- 10,975 (76.3%) of the uniformed staff were deployed in the 270 custodial prison units countrywide;
- Staff attrition for the period July 2025 and March 2026 was 234 staff including 17 staff for the month of March 2026.
- The staff-to-prisoner ratio remained at 1:7.

1.1 Population Change

During the month of March 2026, the overall daily average population of prisoners increased by 0.4% (279) from 79,419 in February 2026 to 79,698.

During the same period as observed from Table 1.1:

- Convicts increased by 0.9% from 41,850 to 42,236;
- Remands decreased by 0.5% from 36,964 to 36,783;
- Civil/judgment debtors increased by 12.2% from 605 to 679;
- Prisons holding capacity increased by 0.3% from 23,184 prisoners to 23,254 prisoners due to the completion of storage building with 02 prison wards each of 35 prisoners capacity at UG. Prison Luzira Women;
- Occupancy rate increased by 0.1% from 342.6% to 342.7%.

1.2 Percentage composition of Remands, Convicts and Debtors

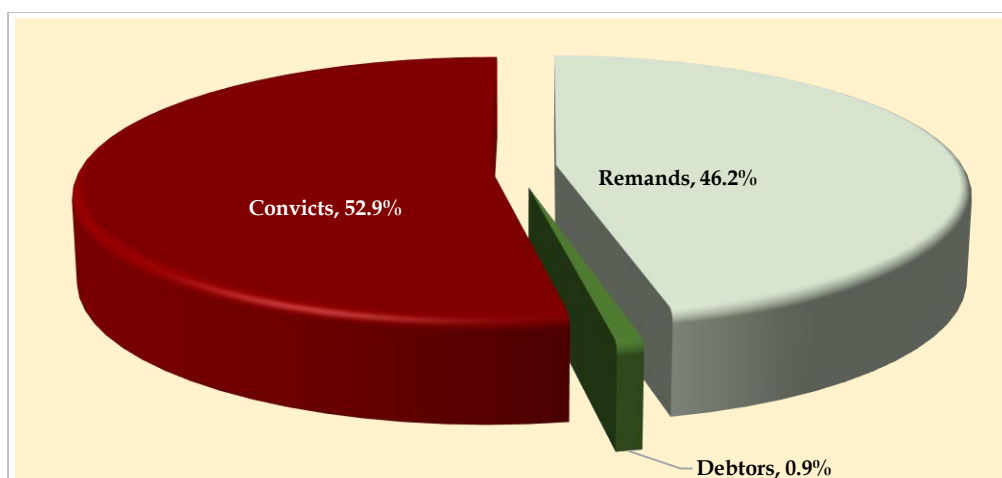


Figure 1.1 Composition of the Prison population

During the month of March 2026, convicted prisoners composed of 52.9%, remand prisoners composed of 46.2%, while civil debtors composed of 0.9%, of the daily average prison population as indicated in Figure 1.1 above.

1.3 Percentage composition change of Remands, Convicts, and Debtors

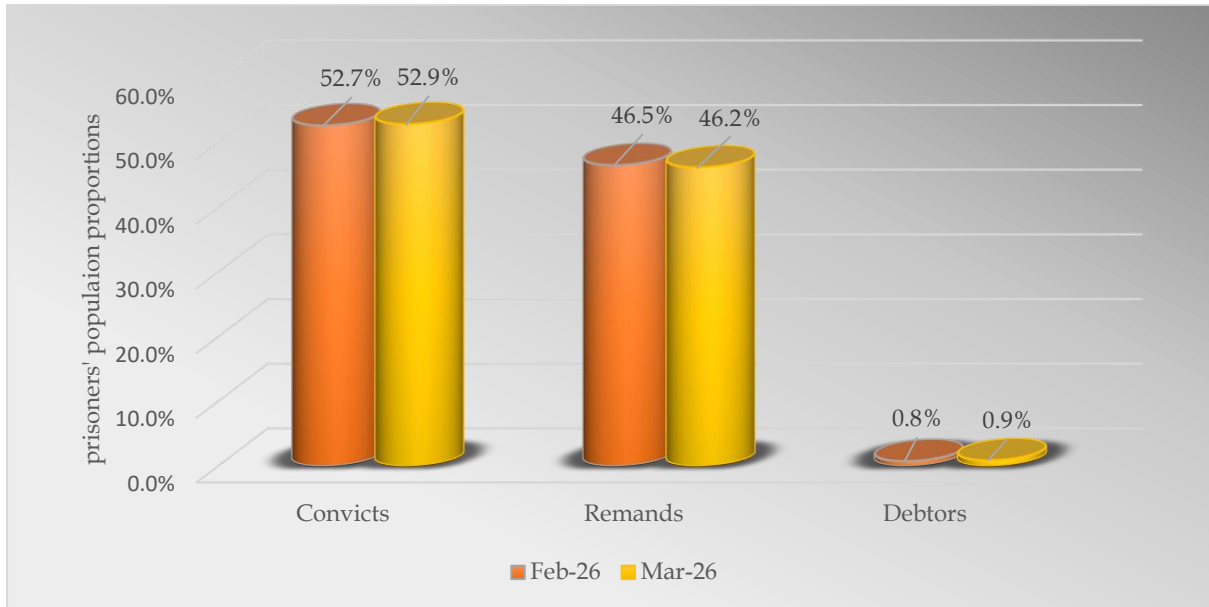


Figure 1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors

In comparison with the month of February 2026, the percentage composition of convicted prisoners increased by 0.2% from 52.7% to 52.9%, remand prisoners decreased by 0.3% from 46.5% to 46.2% while that of civil debtors increased by 0.1% from 0.8% to 0.9%; of the average prison population in March 2026 as indicated in the Figure 1.2 above.

1.4 Monthly Prison Population trends from July 2025 to March 2026

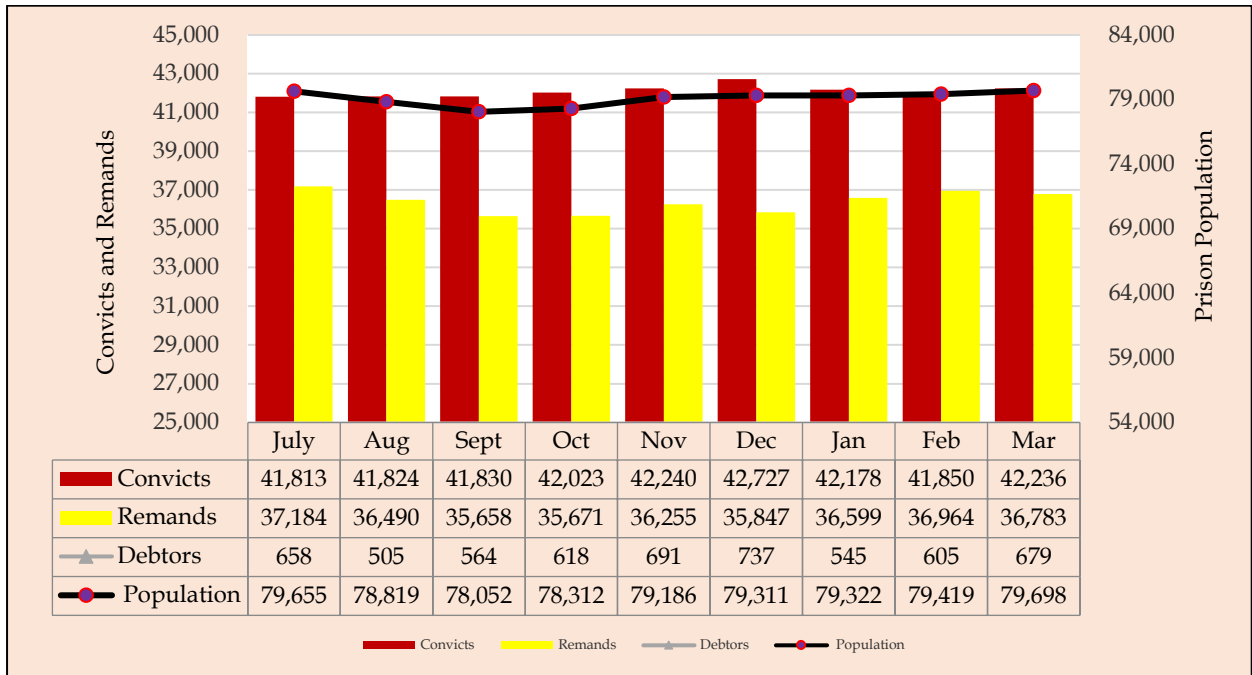


Figure 1.3 Monthly prison population trend for the period July 2025-March 2026

Figure 1.3 above shows the prison population trend from July 2025 to March 2026. The figure indicates a general downward trend in the prison population between July 2025 and September 2025. During this period, the monthly prison population gradually decreased from 79,655 prisoners to 78,052 prisoners. The prison population however, started portraying an upward trend from 78,312 prisoners in October 2025, to the current 79,698 prisoners in March 2026.

1.5 Prison population composition trends from July 2025 to March 2026

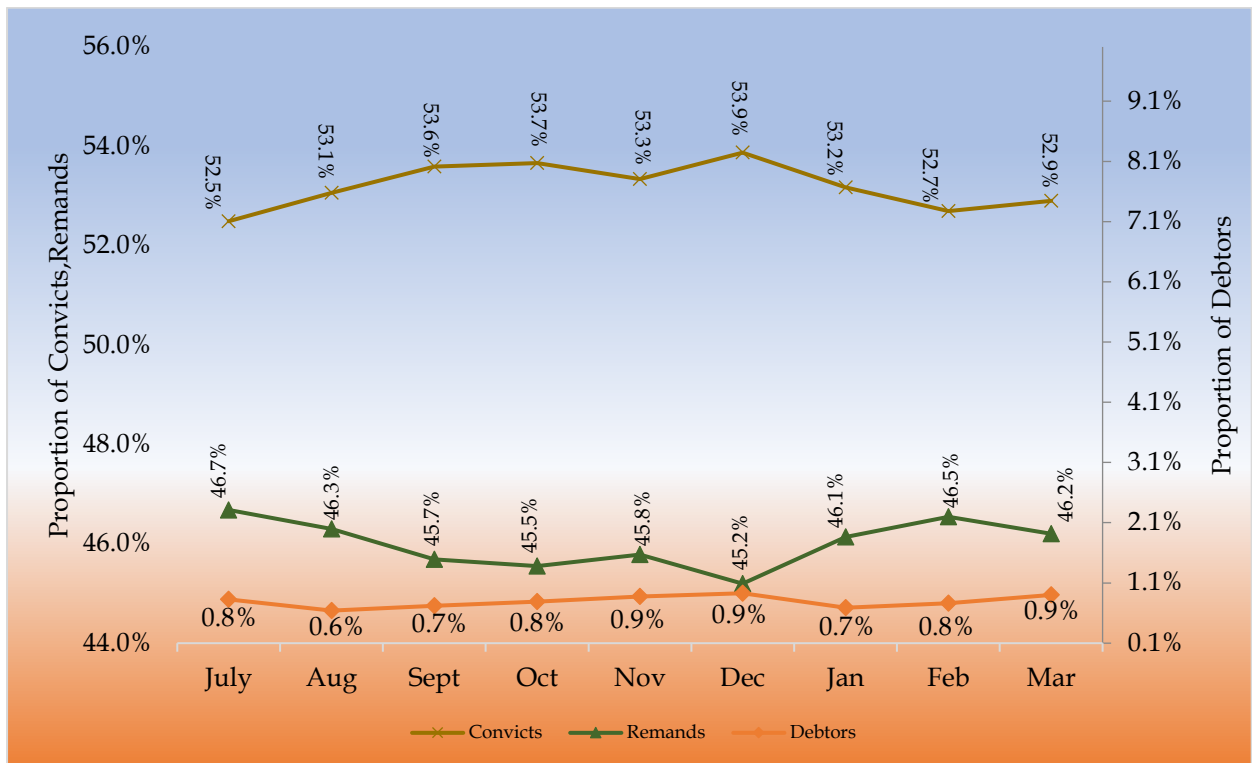


Figure 1.4 Composition trends of convicts, remands, and debtors for the period between July 2025 and March 2026

Figure 1.4 above shows the proportion of convicts, remands, and debtors of the total prison population from July 2025 to March 2026. The proportion of the remand population oscillated below the 50.0% mark, decreasing from 46.7% in July 2025 to 45.2% in December 2025, with an increase to 46.2% in March 2026. On the other hand, the proportion of convicts oscillated above the 50.0% mark, increasing from 52.5% in July 2025 to 53.9% in December 2025, with a decrease to 52.9% in March 2026. On average, the proportion of debtors was 0.8% of the overall prison population for the entire period.

Table 1.2 shows that during the month of March, 2026;

1. The regional prison population increased in the following regions; Mid Northern by 3.6%; North Eastern by 3.3%; Kampala Extra by 2.7%; Kooki by 1.7%; East Central by 1.4%; Northern by 1.2%; Western by 0.8%; North Central and North Western by 0.7%; Eastern by 0.6%; and South Eastern by 0.4%.
2. The regional prison population however, decreased in the following regions; Mid Western by 4.4%, Kigezi by 2.6%; Mid Central by 2.2%; Southern by 1.9%; South Western by 1.0%; Mid Eastern by 0.8%; Iganga by 0.6%; and Central by 0.2%.
3. The average number of children staying in prisons with their incarcerated mothers was 287.

4. The average number of debtors in custody was 679.
5. The staff to prisoner ratio remained at 1:7. The number of prisoners per custodial staff ranged between four (4) and ten (10) across the 19 administrative regions.

1.7 Status of Congestion/Occupancy levels in prison units

Table 1.3 below shows the levels of congestion in prisons during the month of March 2026. Only 7.0% of the prisons (19 prison units) were extremely congested with occupancy levels of above 600%. 132 prison units were very congested with congestion levels between 301% and 600%, constituting 48.9% of the total prison units. Only 39 prison units had congestion levels below 200%. See Annex 4 showing the stations under each category.

During the month of March 2026, the outturn of prisoners delivered to judicial courts countrywide to access justice increased by 10.7% from 38,680 in February 2026 to 42,835 prisoners, a daily average of 1,947 prisoners. (See Table 1.4).

The outturn of normal releases of convicts in March 2026 increased by 23.2% from 2,222 in February 2026 to 2,738 prisoners, a daily average of 105 normal releases of convicts (See Table 1.4).

1.9 Releases of remand prisoners

The outturn of prisoners released from court during the month of March 2026 increased by 17.2% from 7,772 in February 2026 to 9,111 prisoners. The breakdown is as shown in Table 1.5 below.

Table 1.10 indicates the escapes registered between July 2025 and March 2026. The number of escapees per 1,000 prisoners was highest in Kooki region at 11.6 escapees per 1,000 prisoners and lowest in Western Region at 0.7 per 1,000 prisoners. Kampala Extra region had zero escapes during the time period. The overall escape rate during the period was 2.1 escapees per 1,000 prisoners. It is noteworthy that of the 170 prisoners who had escaped from lawful custody during the period, 89 had been recaptured, representing a recapture rate of 52.4%.

1.12 Mortality of Prisoners

During the month of March 2026, the Service lost a total of fourteen (14) prisoners through deaths, majority of whom died from Murchison Bay prison where the prisoners' National Referral Hospital is situated.

The number of deaths registered amongst prisoners during the month of March 2026 was 14, an increase by 16.7% from 12 deaths registered during the previous month (February 2026) as indicated in Table 1.12 above. The monthly crude mortality rate remained at 0.2 deaths per 1,000 prisoners.

Table 1.13 above shows the mortality of prisoners registered between July 2025 and March 2026. Kampala Extra region had the highest crude mortality rate at 5.6 deaths per 1,000 prisoners. North Eastern and Central region had not registered death of prisoners during the time period. The overall number of deaths in the time period was 125 against the daily average prison population of 79,087 prisoners, reflecting an overall crude mortality rate of 1.6 deaths per 1,000 prisoners.

2 STAFFING POSITION

2.1 Staff Strength

The Service staff strength as at 31st March 2026 was 14,850 constituting 10,337 (69.6%) males and 4,513 (30.4%) females. Of the same strength, 14,375 were uniformed staff while 475 were non-uniformed staff. Of the 14,375 uniformed staff, 1,238 staff (912 males and 326 females) were undergoing the Basic Prison Training Course at the Prisons Academy and Training School (PATS) in Luzira as shown in Table 2.1 below.

Of the 14,375 uniformed staff, 10,975 (76.3%) were deployed in custodial units across the 270 Prisons countrywide. Therefore, the overall staff-to-prisoner ratio was 1:7 against the ideal of 1:3.
